

PROTOCOL #00: PRE-FLIGHT BRIEFING

Your "Safe Landing" Script for Gay Cuck Couples



Use this checklist before the engines warm up. Discuss these points with a clear head so that during the landing—when the hormonal rush might cloud your vision—you know exactly what to do.

1. Establishing the Landing Zone (The Moment after Climax)

- **The Guest (Bull):** Should he leave discreetly right away? Should he stay for a drink? Or should he leave the room so the couple can be alone?
- **First Contact:** When will potential restraints/the cage be released? Who makes the first move toward reconnection?
- **The Cleanup:** Is the cleanup part of the "script" and the fantasy, or is it a functional task to be handled quickly?

2. Decompression (The First 30 Minutes After)

- **Physical Touch:** Do you need "Aftercare" cuddling, or does everyone need 10 minutes of space first (showering, breathing)?
- **The Vibe:** Do you want to talk about the experience immediately (high-energy) or close the gap by doing something completely normal (Netflix, pizza, chocolate)?
- **The Signal:** Is there a specific word or gesture that means: "I am fully back in the here and now"?

3. Communication (Rules for the Couple)

- **No Analysis During the Rush:** Agree not to discuss critical points until the next day. Right after the flight, emotions are often too unstable for constructive feedback.
- **Affirmation:** A simple "I love you" or "That was amazing with you" is the most important bridge back to daily life.

4. Emergency Protocols (Alternate Destinations)

- What do we do if someone suddenly feels uncomfortable or experiences "Sub-Drop"?
- Where is the "Safety Blanket" (both physically and emotionally)?
